ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 1 ENTRY:

The English Entrance Exam will consist of:

Alphabet

Students should know the names of all the letters of the alphabet and their sounds (both upper and lower case) and be able to write them in order.

Reading

Students will be required to read a simple passage based on high frequency sight words and word families using their knowledge of phonics (mostly short /a/ and /o/).

High Frequency Word Recognition

Students will be expected to recognize and read out loud high frequency sight words that are attached.

Sentence Writing

Students will be shown a picture and be asked to describe what is happening in the picture verbally and then be asked to write down what they see in the picture.

MATH REQUIREMENTS for GRADE 1 Entry

The Math Entrance Exam will consist of questions on the following basic concepts:

Number concepts

- Read, write and count numbers and objects to 30
- Count onwards (0-20) and backwards (20-0)

Operations

- Add and subtract to 20
- Recognize terms less and more than in relation to numbers
- Order numbers from least to greatest to 20
- Find doubles of single digits to at least 5
- Share objects into equal groups

Measurement and geometry

- Recognize 2D shapes
- Order pictures in the correct sequence
- Recognize which shapes are halved
- Recognize the terms shorter, longer, heavier, lighter in relation to measurements
