

KG2 Entry Expectations

Developmental expectations:

In Arabic and English, students are expected to read, write and recognize letters studied in KG1.

Able to read and write their own name correctly.

Able to write holding a pencil correctly.

Can follow two or three step directions.

Draw a detailed picture and explain it in Arabic and English.

Answer comprehension questions orally based on a picture in Arabic and English.

Can recognise and write all numbers from 1 to 10 in English and Arabic.

Sorts and classifies objects.

Understands and creates patterns.

Can recognise 11 colors.

Can recognise basic 2-Dimensional shapes.

Able to cut out simple shapes with scissors.
